

What are Empowerment Classes?

The empowerment classes are designed to educate and equip women with information and skills needed to gain control over their lives and live a life free of violence. The program consists of twelve classes dealing with the impact of the cycle of violence on the entire family. The W.I.N.S. program is based on the "Empowerment Model", which is a nonpsychotherapeutic approach that sees domestic violence as an imbalance of power within relationships. This desire for control over the other is evident by physical, mental, verbal, sexual, emotional, psychological or economical abuses. The program centers on the belief that women and children can break the cycle of domestic violence through support, resources, advocacy, information, and education, always striving to equalize power between a women and her environment.
